
SILENCE AFTER THE STORM

TAGLINE

In time of existential threat to the indigenous Assyrian Christian minority by ISIS, the filmmaker travels back to his ancestral homeland, Syria, through a journey of nostalgia and discovery.

SYNOPSIS

After ISIS kidnapped many of his relatives in Syria, Fadi, a local Assyrian artist, reflects on his people's dire condition in profound and ironic thoughts. While he's working on his new art piece at his rundown workshop, a filmmaker from Los Angeles, Sargon, travels back to his wartorn ancestral homeland aiming to expose the atrocities and search for hope.

During his travels on the frontlines in Iraq, he meets a charismatic young activist, Savina, who offers unique insight into the inner conflict within the endangered community.

The film concludes in southeastern Turkey in a region where the first major tragedy hit in 1915, a century before ISIS.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

"Growing up I heard countless stories from my grandparents about past massacres and century-old genocides inflicted on our people. I always thought to myself what I would have done if I lived in an age where we were facing horrific threats like that. How would I have reacted? When I was a kid, I thought that I would probably be a soldier and kill some bad guys.

Now, that I am grown up, it turns out to be that I would be a filmmaker instead.

In the last few years, a new threat of ethnic cleansing is facing my people, the indigenous Assyrians, in the Middle East. This time by the Islamic terrorist organization, ISIS.

In 2014, I flew to Iraq to document the lives of the Yazidi and Assyrian displaced families who were forced out of their homes by ISIS. I named the film *"The Last Plight"* thinking it would be the beginning of the end. I was wrong!

In 2015, I found myself in Syria this time, documenting new atrocities. *"Silence After The Storm"* is a very close film to my heart as it captures the overall mood of a people in a delicate and personal way. I hope many people can relate to it." - Sargon Saadi
